Trailer By-law

If you have a recreational trailer such as a travel trailer, RV, or a motorhome on a property that is being used as accommodation, you are required to purchase a trailer license. These license fees fund municipal services such as fire, ambulance, policing, roads, landfills, and more. Visit www.neebing.org/trailerlicence for more information.

Emergency Response Registry

The Emergency Response Registry is a joint venture between Neebing's Emergency Management and Emergency Services departments. The Emergency Response Registry is a service that allows residents with disabilities and/or their caregivers to submit critical information about their living accommodations. The information is used to assist firefighters and emergency responders to quickly locate and/or contact individuals so we can provide additional care in the case of an emergency such as an evacuation. 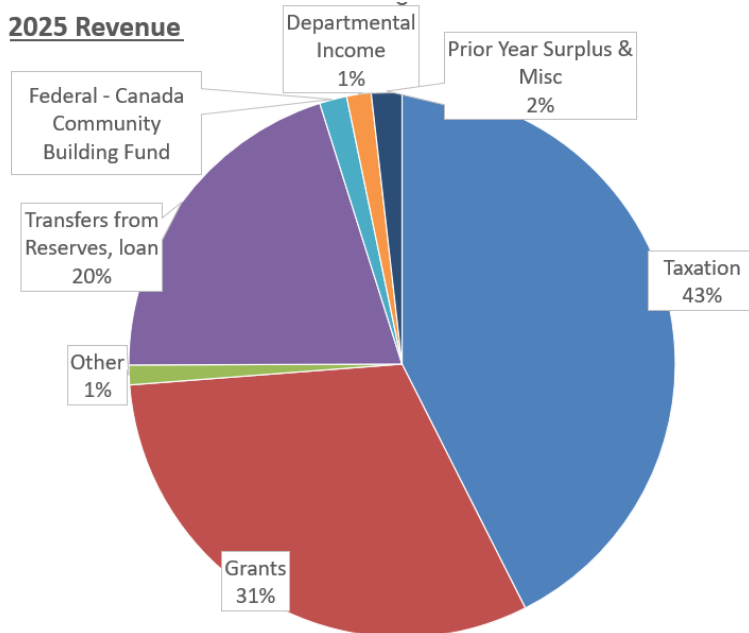

2025 Budget Highlights

Revenue Sources: Neebing's two highest revenue sources are property taxes and grants. The Province provides three types of grants to Neebing: unconditional grants, conditional grants which must be spent on specific items, and grants that require applications. Revenues also include transfers from reserves along with a construction loan for the Fire Safety Bay.

Operating Expenses: Maintaining Neebing's 500 lane kilometres of roads makes up the largest operating expense. Transfers to other service organization (Policing, Thunder Bay District Social Services Administration Board, etc.) form the next largest expense followed by Administration and General Government, then Fire and Emergency Services.

Capital Expenses: This category includes the Fire Safety Bay, Roadwork and work on Municipal Properties. Total Capital expenses budgeted for 2025 are \$4,333,848.
