### Significant Weather Events

A municipality may declare a "Significant Weather Event" if there is an approaching or occurring weather hazard with the potential to pose a significant danger to users of the highways within a municipality.

This declaration suspends the standard timelines required for municipalities to meet their winter maintenance objectives until the municipality declares the significant weather event has ended. Once the declaration has ended, standard timelines for winter maintenance activities will begin.

The intent of a declaration is to notify the public that due to the current weather conditions, caution is to be exercised when travelling on the municipality's roads, and that it may take longer than usual to restore them to normal conditions.

## Snow Clearing

Municipal roads have different classifications based on traffic counts. The class indicates how snow clearing and other road work is performed. See the Roads Maintenance Policy on our website for details.

There is no parking allowed on municipal roadways from December 15<sup>th</sup> to May 31<sup>st</sup> to allow Neebing's roads crew to clear snow. Thank you for not parking on the roads.

Placing snow on the roadway creates a safety hazard for other vehicles. It is against both municipal by-laws and the Province's Highway Traffic Act. Please help keep the roads safe for everyone!

## Landfill Punch cards can be used until they expire on July 31, 2026

New Punch cards will arrive with the final tax bill which is mailed out in July and can be used starting August 1, 2026. Watch for the white envelope with the fluorescent "Landfill Punch Card Enclosed" sticker on the front of it.

## Blake Hall Available for Booking

Blake Hall and the Outdoor Pavillion at Century Park can be reserved for special events. Groups offering events that are open to the public may have reduced rental fees. Call the office for details.

## Fire Burn Permits

Fire Permits are required all year for fires larger than 3 feet x 3 feet. Campfires require permits from April 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup> each year. Permits can be obtained online beginning April 1<sup>st</sup> by visiting <http://www.neebing.org/firepermits>. Fireworks permits are issued by the Fire Chief.
