

RENTAL RATES

A \$250 refundable damage deposit is required for all rentals.

Indoor Rentals:

\$25 per hour fee for general events with a minimum 2 hour rental. Events involving liquor subject to an additional \$125 fee with proof of liquor licence.

Wedding bookings include 3 full days (set up, event day, take down) \$400 fee.

No rental charge for funeral events or non-profit organizations. Some exceptions apply.

Outdoor Rentals:

Summer: The Pavilion rental rate is \$40 per hour.

*Winter: Private ice time rentals available from 7 am to 12 pm at \$75 per hour.

**Winter season availability approximately December to March*

Facilities

The Blake Community Hall is the perfect venue for large events such as weddings, retirement parties, bridal and baby showers, and birthdays. It is also the ideal space for business conferences, club meetings, exercise classes, training sessions, and more.

The outdoor Pavilion is suitable for both summer and winter events like markets, festivals, car shows, hockey tournaments, and more.

INDOOR SPACE

Blake Community Hall is a self-catered event space that can accommodate 160 standing and 100 seated at tables with entertainment space. The Hall offers a large display TV, microphone and sound system, WiFi, speaker's podium, accessible washroom, a full kitchen with two stoves, cooking utensils, commercial coffee maker, thirty 6-foot tables and 100 chairs. There is an assortment of plates, cutlery, and coffee cups available. Renters are responsible for Hall set-up, tear-down, and clean-up for their events. Please note that no table linens or drinking glasses are provided.

OUTDOOR SPACE

The outdoor Pavilion is a large timber frame 50' x 115' open air building. The Pavilion has a concrete surface during the summer months then converts to a maintained skating rink in the winter complete with hockey boards and nets. These boards, which remain in place year round, are designed with a 'drive-in' entrance and 2 walk-in entrances. The Pavilion is equipped with overhead lighting, full electrical service and one set of bleachers. Renters must provide their own furniture (tables and chairs) for use outside in the Pavilion.
