RECOMMENDATION:

The Waste Management Committee recommends that Council change the hours for the land fill sites as follows:

Sand Hill:

- Saturdays: 9:00 am – 5:00 pm (All Year)
- Tuesdays: 12:00 pm – 8:00 pm (Summer)
- Tuesdays: 12:00 pm – 4:00 pm (Winter)

Total per week (Winter): 12 hours
(Summer): 16 hours

Scoble:

- Sundays: 9:00 am – 5:00 pm (All Year)
- Wednesdays: 12:00 pm – 8:00 pm (Summer)
- Wednesdays: 12:00 pm – 4:00 pm (Winter)

Total per week (Winter): 12 hours
(Summer): 16 hours

AND THAT the change be effective August 1, 2026 to correspond with the new punch card cycle.

BACKGROUND:

The Municipality conducted a public survey to gather feedback on proposed changes to landfill operating hours at the Sand Hill and Scoble landfill sites.

The survey was available from March 19 to May 5, 2026, in both online and paper formats. A total of 275 responses were received.

The current hours are:

Winter (Oct 1–Mar 31):

- Saturdays: 9:00 am – 5:00 pm (8 hours)
- Sundays: 12:00 pm – 4:00 pm (4 hours)

Total per week (Winter): 12 hours

Summer (Apr 1–Sept 30):

- Saturdays: 9:00 am – 5:00 pm (8 hours)
- Sundays: 4:00 pm – 8:00 pm (4 hours)
- Wednesdays: 4:00 pm – 8:00 pm (4 hours)

Total per week (Summer): 16 hours

The hours proposed in the survey were:Winter (Oct 1–Mar 31):

- Saturdays: 11:00 am – 5:00 pm (6 hours)
- Sundays: 11:00 am – 5:00 pm (6 hours)

Total per week (Winter): 12 hours

Summer (Apr 1–Sept 30):Sandhill

- Saturdays: 11:00 am – 5:00 pm (6 hours)
- Sundays: 11:00 am – 5:00 pm (6 hours)
- Mondays: 4:00 pm – 8:00 pm (4 hours)

Total per week (Summer): 16 hours

Scoble

- Saturdays: 11:00 am – 5:00 pm (6 hours)
- Sundays: 11:00 am – 5:00 pm (6 hours)
- Fridays: 4:00 pm – 8:00 pm (4 hours)

Total per week (Summer): 16 hours

The Waste Management Committee reviewed the survey results and compared Neebing's landfill hours with area municipalities on May 12, 2026.

DISCUSSION:

Overall, there is public support for adjusting landfill hours; however, public comments highlighted several key considerations that should be taken into account before making any changes.

The Committee reviewed these considerations and is recommending hours that differ from those proposed in the survey. The recommended schedule aims to balance strong public input requesting earlier morning access and the availability of weekday hours, while also supporting a better work-life balance for staff.

Administration reviewed the 2025 landfill tracking sheets and found that, on average, 27% of visitors on Saturdays arrived between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Based on this data, the Committee felt it was important to maintain the 9:00 a.m. opening time on weekends.

It was also noted that not all municipalities operate their landfill sites three days per week; therefore, it was considered reasonable for Neebing to adjust to two operating days. Additionally, given current fuel costs, staff expressed a preference for working two longer shifts rather than a combination of one long shift and two shorter ones.

The proposed schedule would have the two landfill sites open on different days. This approach would provide the public with access on four separate days while requiring staff to work only two days per week. It would also offer greater flexibility in managing staff coverage for illness and vacations.

Text of Report to Waste Management Committee

The following is a brief summary of survey results. The full survey results are attached to this report (with unedited comments).

Of the respondents who completed the survey, 94.5% were permanent residents and 58.5 % use the Scoble Landfill.

With respect to the landfill hours:

- 75.6% of respondents are satisfied with the current hours
- 73.5% of respondents say the proposed winter hours would work for them
- 58.5% of respondents say the proposed summer hours would work for them

While a majority of respondents indicated that the proposed hours would work for them, support for the proposed summer hours is notably lower than for the winter changes, suggesting greater concern with modifications to the summer schedule.

Proposed Winter Hours

The comments regarding the proposed winter hours reflect mixed views, but several consistent concerns emerged. The most prominent issue is a strong desire for at least one weekday or midweek access option, as many residents cannot use weekend hours due to work schedules, shift work, or other commitments. There is also significant opposition to later opening times (11:00 a.m.), with many preferring earlier starts (around 9:00 a.m.) to complete dump trips before other activities. Respondents noted that weekend-only scheduling is too restrictive, particularly for those who work weekends or are often away, and suggested distributing hours across both weekdays and weekends. While some residents are satisfied with the proposed changes or find them acceptable, others prefer to keep the current schedule or make only minor adjustments. Concerns about garbage accumulation and wildlife attraction, along with general accessibility and convenience, reinforce the need for a more balanced and flexible winter schedule.

Proposed Summer Hours

The comments regarding the proposed summer hours show consistent and strongly held views, with several dominant themes. The most significant concern is the importance of maintaining a midweek operating day, particularly Wednesday, which many residents rely on to manage garbage between weekends. This is closely tied to concerns about wildlife and public safety, as respondents emphasized that prolonged garbage storage in warmer months increases the risk of attracting bears and other animals. There is also notable opposition to clustering hours on consecutive weekend days (e.g., Friday–Sunday or Saturday–Monday), as many residents are away camping or travelling on weekends and would miss access entirely. Similar to winter feedback, many respondents expressed a preference for earlier opening times, especially Saturdays, to avoid waiting until late morning. While some residents are supportive of changes, particularly if they improve staff scheduling, many favour keeping the current summer schedule, especially the existing Wednesday evening hours. Overall, the feedback highlights that midweek access, consistent scheduling, and minimizing garbage accumulation are the key priorities for residents during the summer months.

Analysis

The survey results indicate that resident satisfaction is influenced more by the distribution and timing of hours than by the total number of hours available. In particular, the proposed removal or shifting of midweek access and later weekend start times appear to be the primary drivers of concern. As a result, maintaining a balanced schedule that includes both weekday and weekend access may better meet community needs.

Key Considerations

Based on the comments provided by respondents, some things to consider regarding the proposed hours include:

- **Midweek access** — consistently identified as the most important factor for accessibility across both seasons.
- **Weekend-only or consecutive-day scheduling is limiting** — reduces access for shift workers, weekend workers, and those who travel.
- **Wildlife and garbage buildup are major concerns** — particularly in summer, supporting the need for more frequent access.
- **Earlier opening times are preferred** — especially Saturday mornings, to improve convenience and usability.

These findings suggest that while changes to landfill hours may be supported in principle, adjustments that maintain midweek access, avoid concentrating hours on weekends, and preserve earlier start times may better align with resident priorities.

Conclusion

Overall, the Landfill Hours Survey results indicate that while there is general support for adjusting operating hours, residents place greater importance on how and when access is provided rather than the total number of hours available. Feedback consistently highlights the need for midweek availability, earlier opening times, and a balanced distribution of hours throughout the week to ensure accessibility for a broad range of users, including shift workers and those with weekend commitments. Concerns related to wildlife, garbage accumulation, and convenience further reinforce the importance of frequent and flexible access, particularly during the summer months. While some respondents support changes that improve staff scheduling, many emphasize maintaining or enhancing service levels for residents. Overall, the survey demonstrates that any changes to landfill hours should carefully balance operational efficiency, staff considerations, and the strong community preference for accessible, well-distributed service.

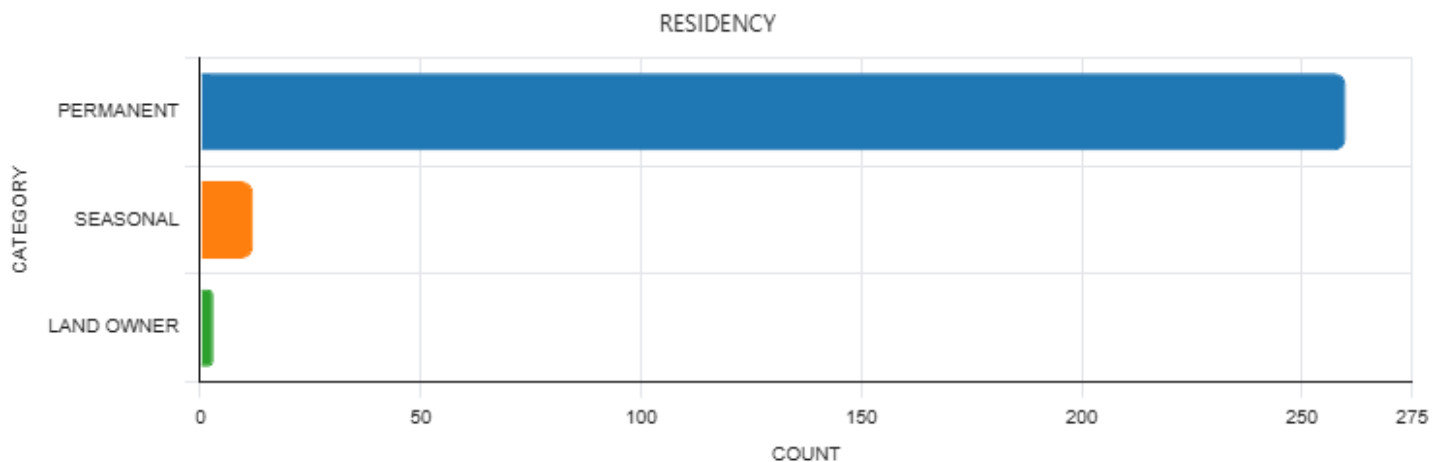

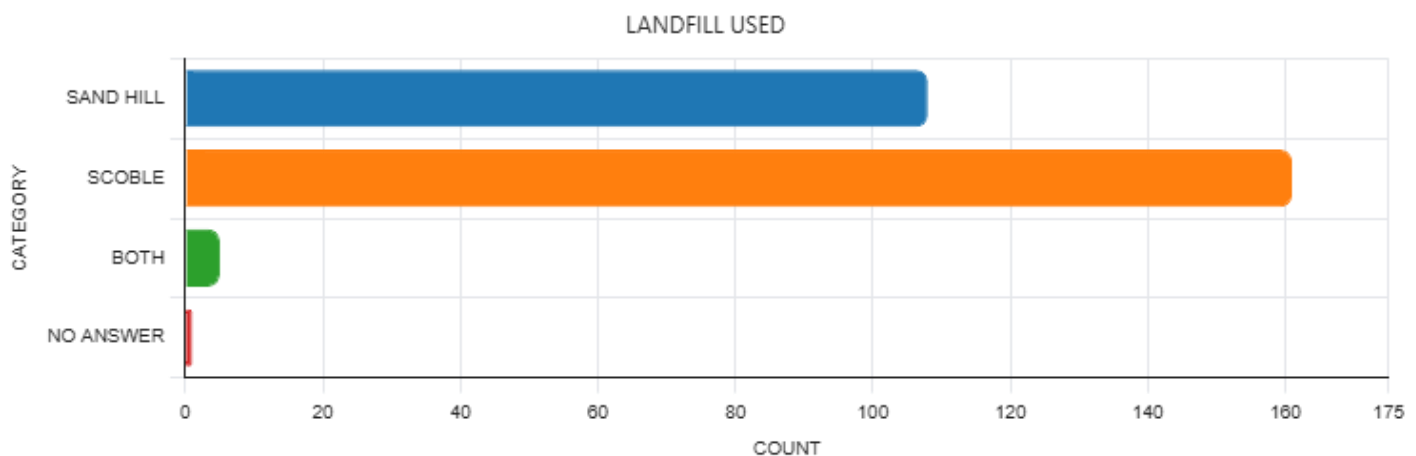
Landfill Hours Survey Results

The Landfill Hours Survey was made available to all residents of Neebing. It could be accessed both online and in paper format, with hard copies available at the Municipal Office and at landfill sites. The survey was open from March 19 to May 5, 2026, and a total of 275 responses were received, including 199 submitted online and 76 collected in paper form. The graphs below present the survey results in both numbers and percentages.



Percentages used (of 275 total):

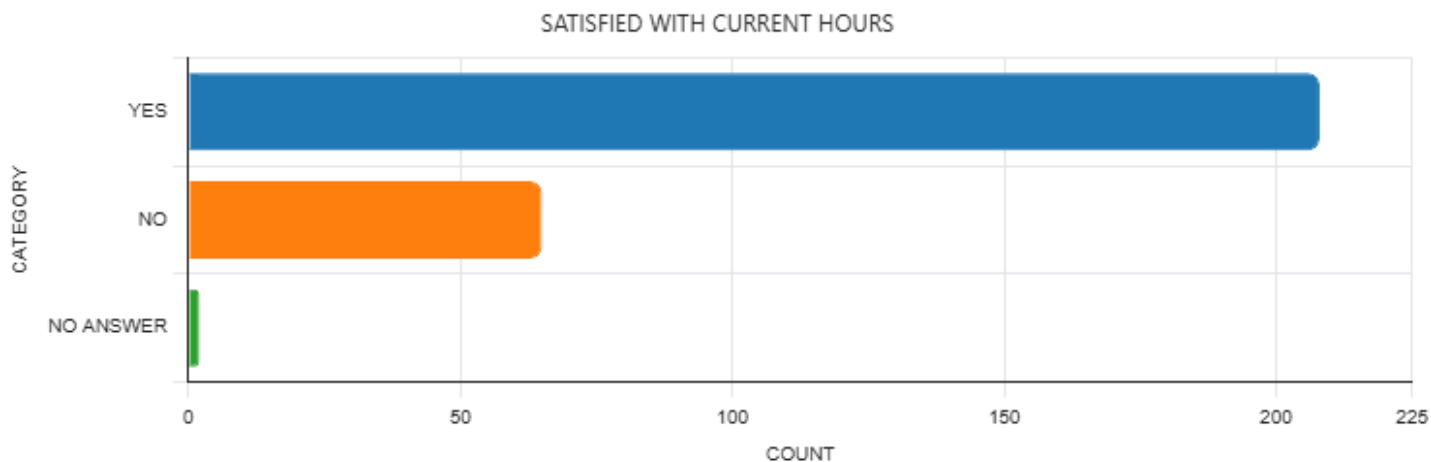
- PERMANENT: 260 → **94.5%**

Percentages (of total 275):

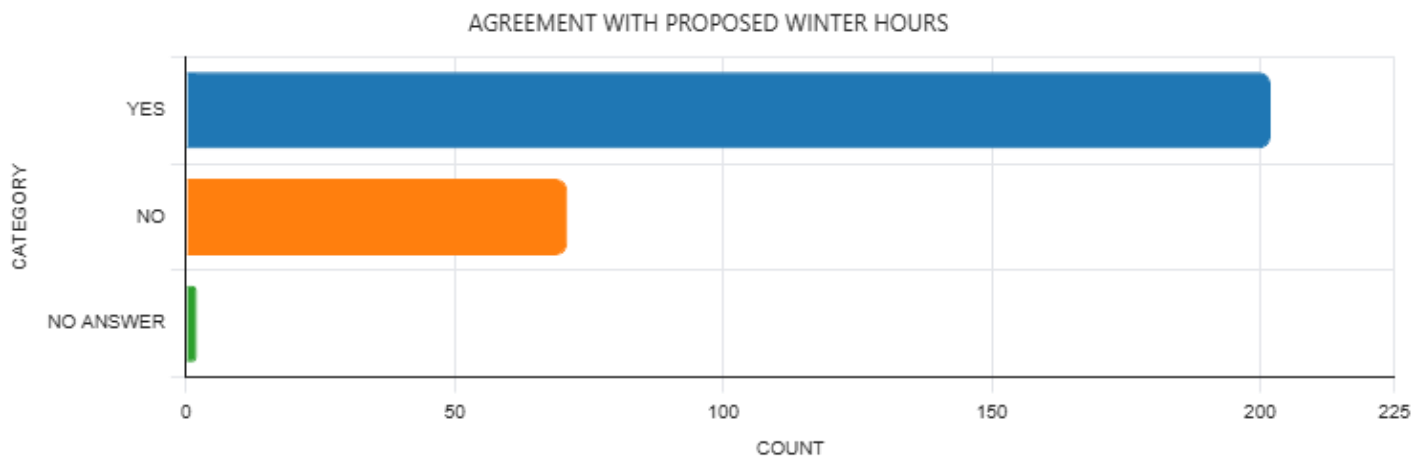
- **SAND HILL: 108 (39.3%)**

Percentages (of total 275):

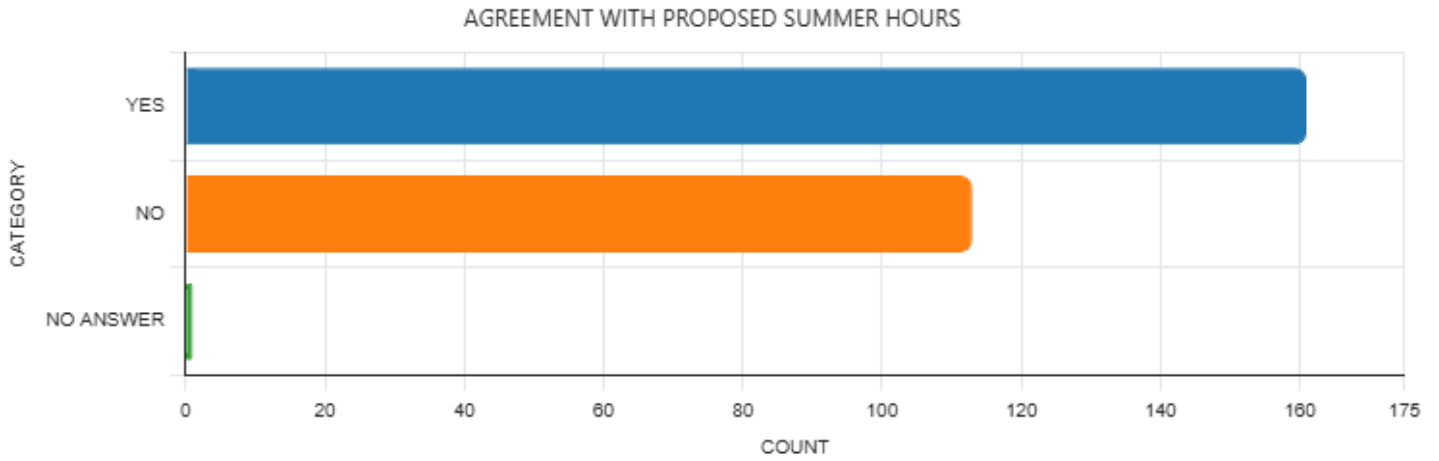
