

<p style="text-align: center;">LANDFILL ATTENDANT 2026</p>

The Landfill Attendant provides the following services:

- Ensure that residents and ratepayers are disposing of waste material into appropriate areas, directing/correcting as needed.
- Ensure that all garbage bags going into the pit have been marked with the municipal bag tag.
- Ensure that material deposited for recycling is sorted and placed in the appropriate bins.
- Ensure that unacceptable materials are not deposited into the recycling bins.
- Advise the Municipal Office when the recycle bins, tire piles and/or electronic waste bins require emptying.
- Monitor the “Good Neighbour Shed” to see that it is not getting cluttered with non-usable items.
- Keep the landfill site (relatively) tidy. Pick-up loose litter in the common areas and relocate items that have been placed in the incorrect area.
- “Police” the site to advise persons of the rules of landfill site use when they are not following the rules (for example, no one is permitted to “scavenge” from the landfill site or enter into the waste pit itself; items placed (free of charge) in the “good neighbour shed” must be in good, re-use-able condition, etc.)
- Complete tipping fee “promise to pay” agreements for demolition waste. (Payment cannot be accepted at the landfill sites.)
- Track the materials entering into the landfill site and submit reports to the Municipal Office.

This is a part-time, non-union, position. The 2026 wage is set at \$23.55 per hour. 4% vacation pay is paid in addition to the wage.

The landfill attendant must be able to do some lifting, maintain a clean site, and work, for the most part, out-of-doors, with limited supervision. Good communication skills and the ability to deal tactfully with the public are required. Knowledge of waste management principles and regulations is an asset.

Maintaining health & safety is a Municipal priority. All workers, including the landfill attendants, must work prudently without risk-taking, and wear all personal protective equipment that is required. Mandatory health and safety training sessions must be attended. This position is in a rural forested location and wildlife hazards could exist.
